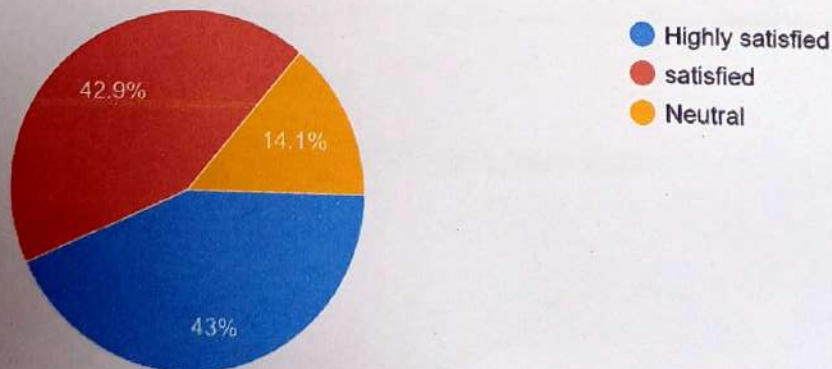

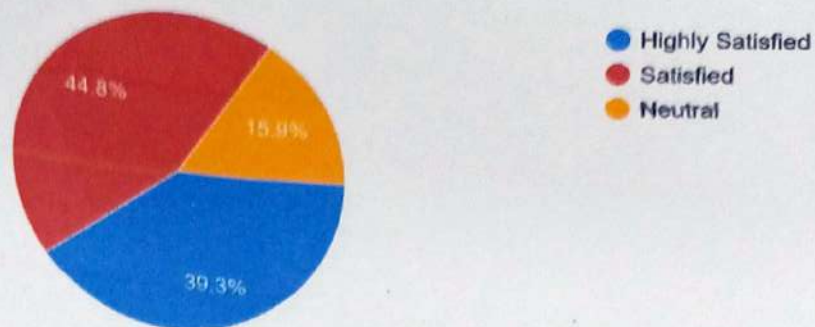

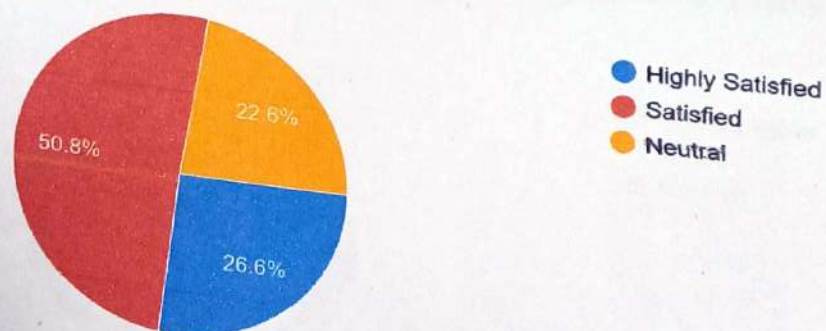

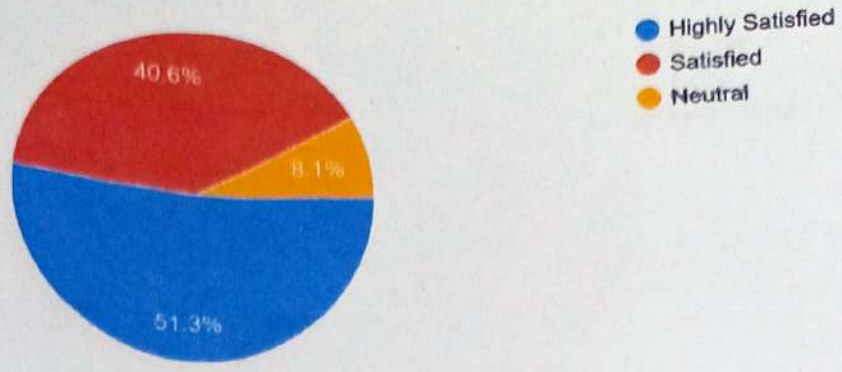

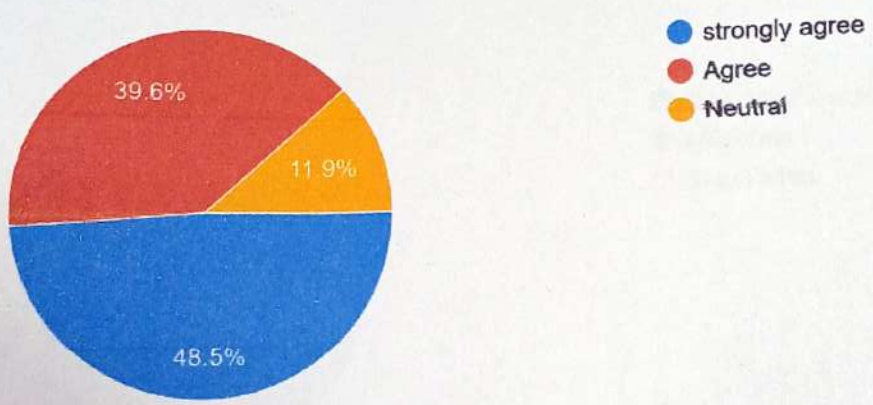

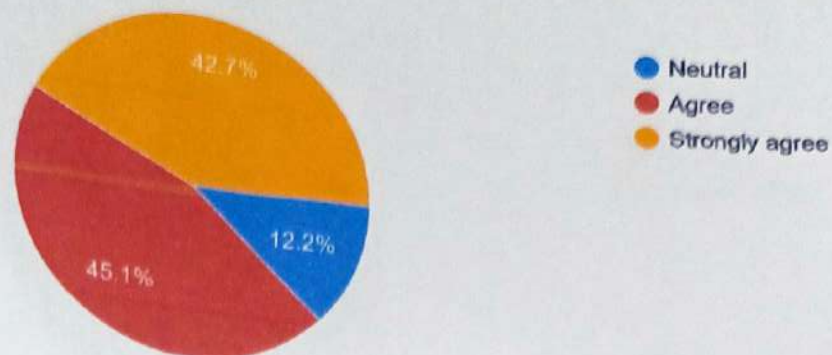

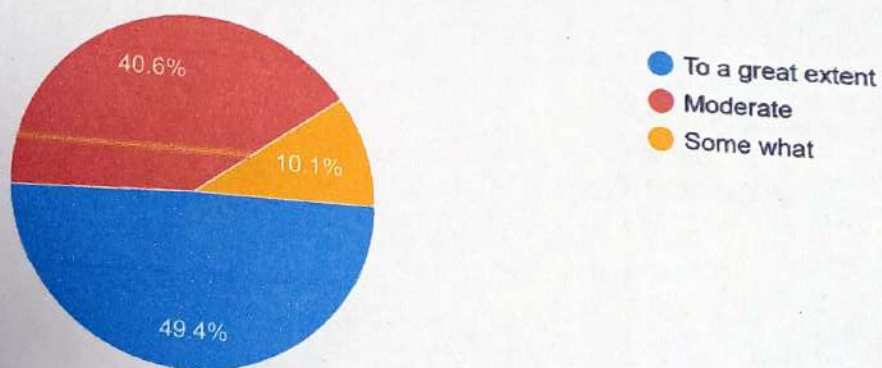

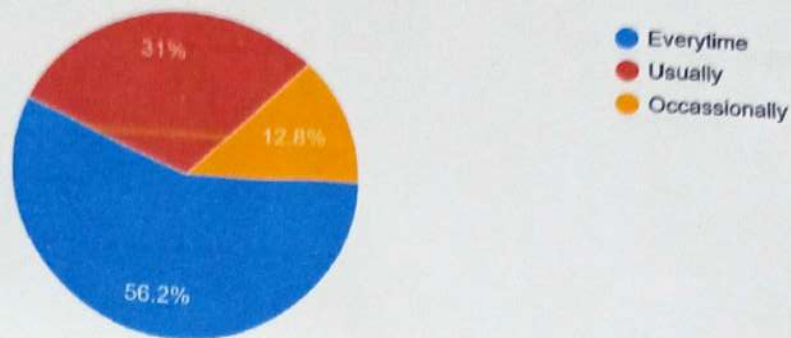

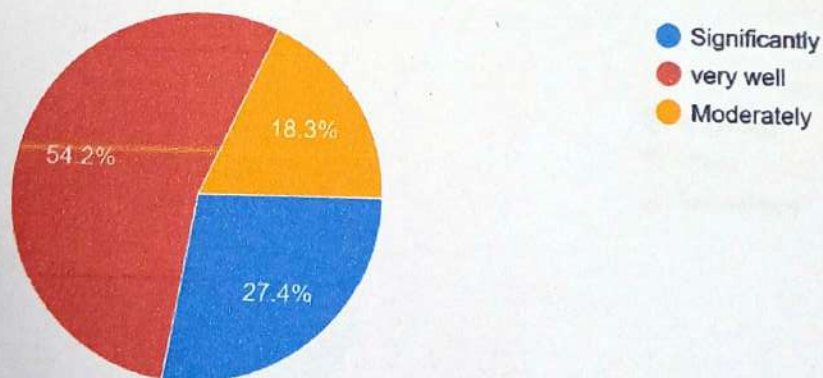

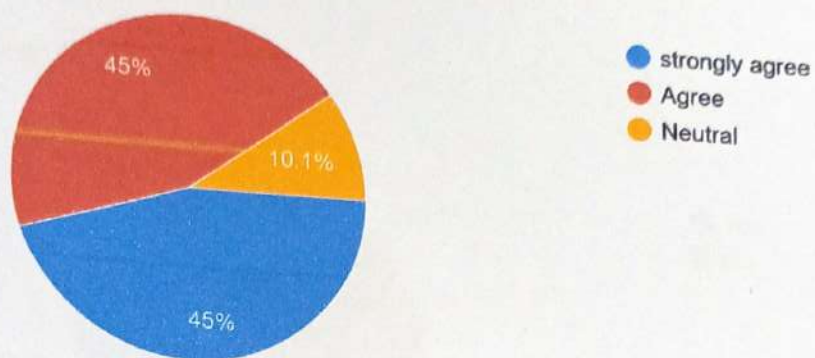

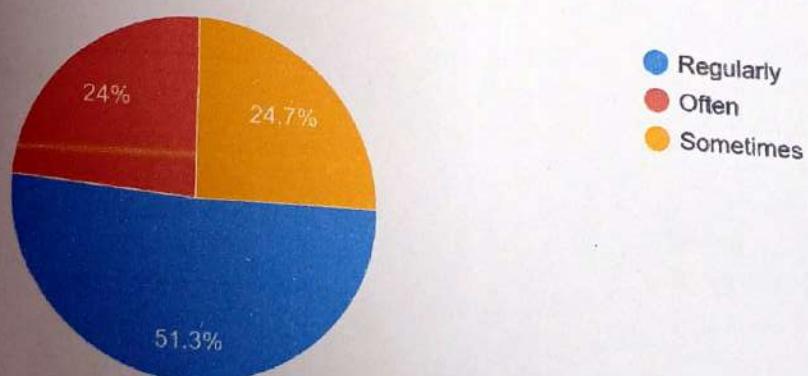

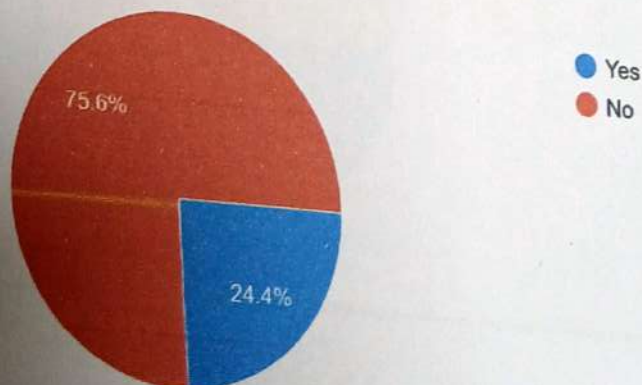

Action Taken: Maximum girls belongs to rural ares and not allowed to study further still counselling sessions are organised to encourage them for higher education.

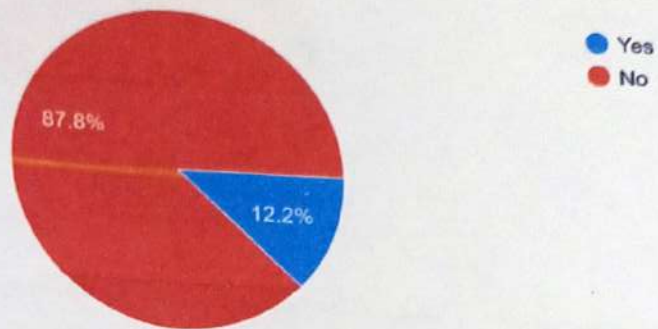

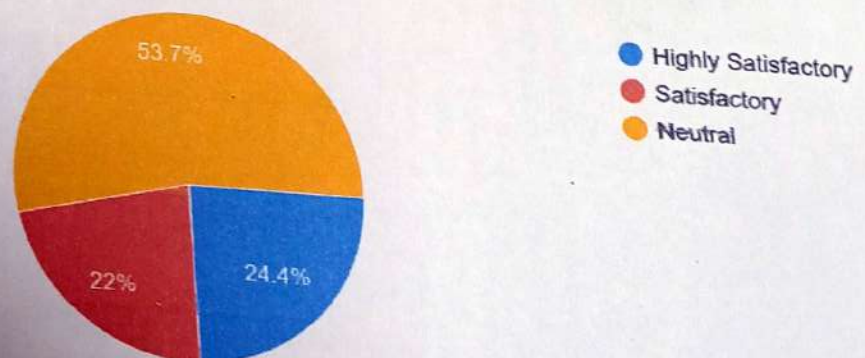

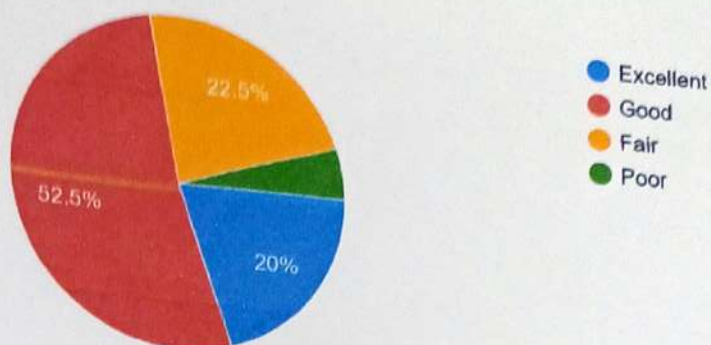

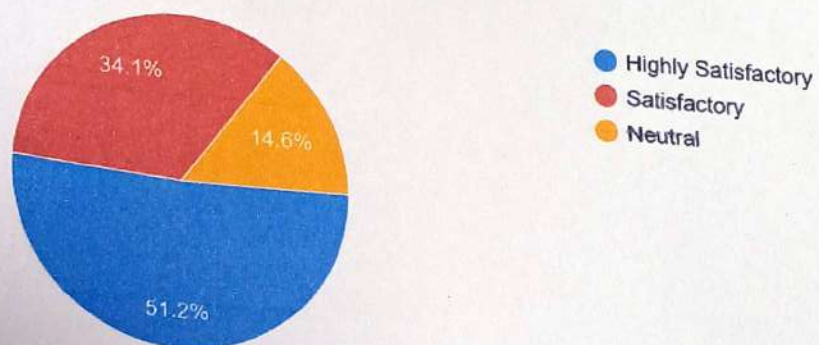

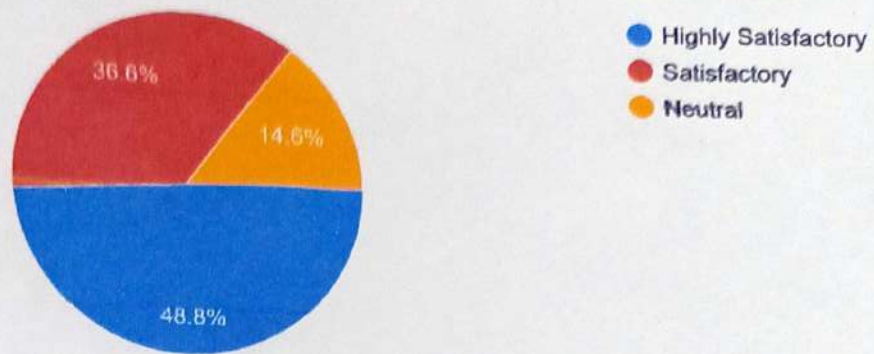

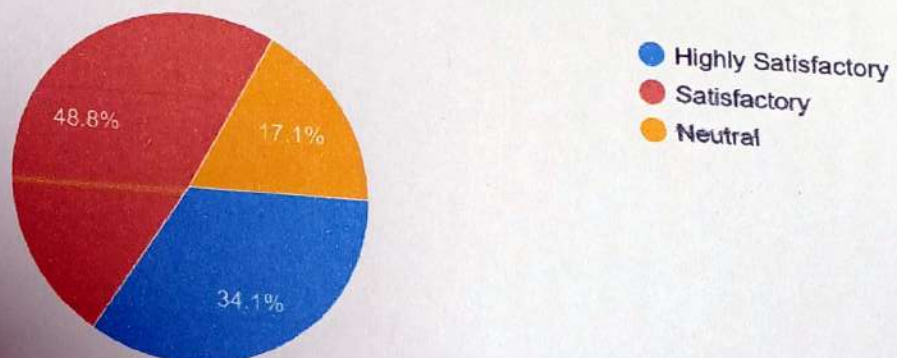

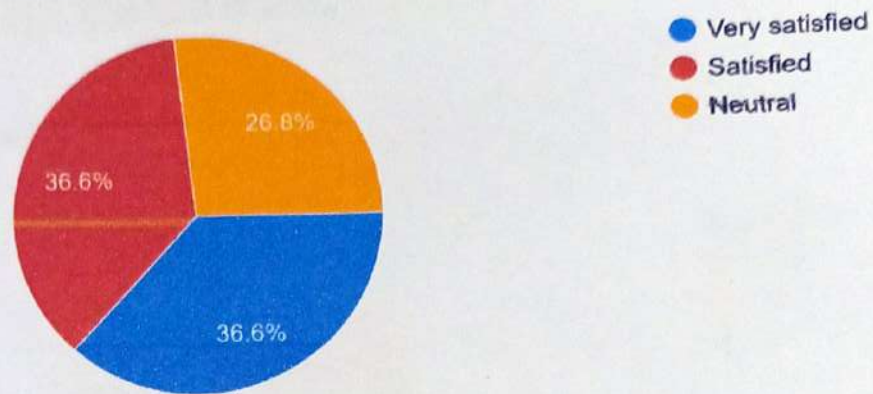

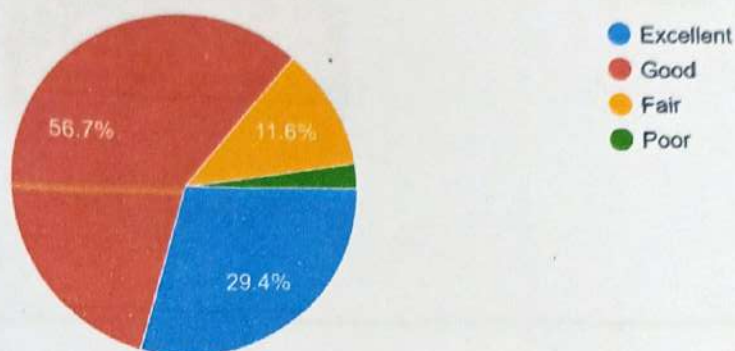

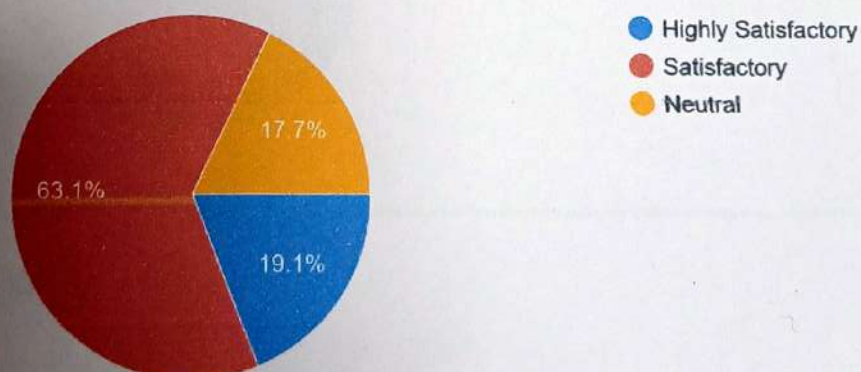

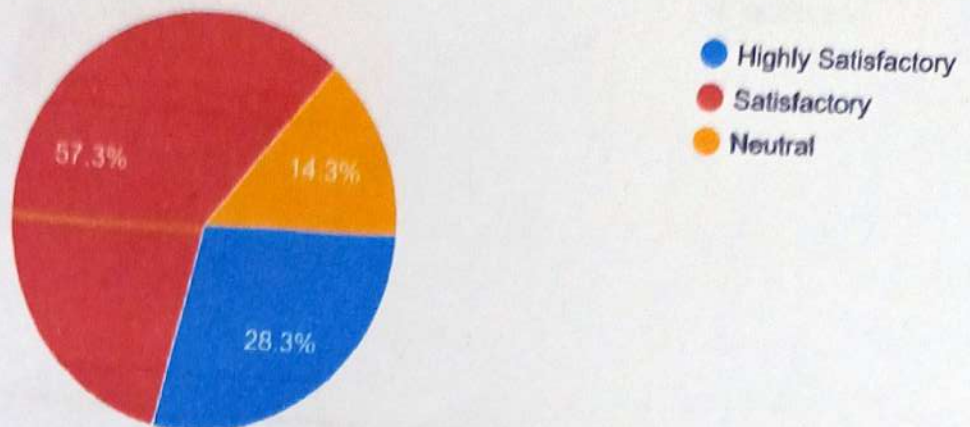

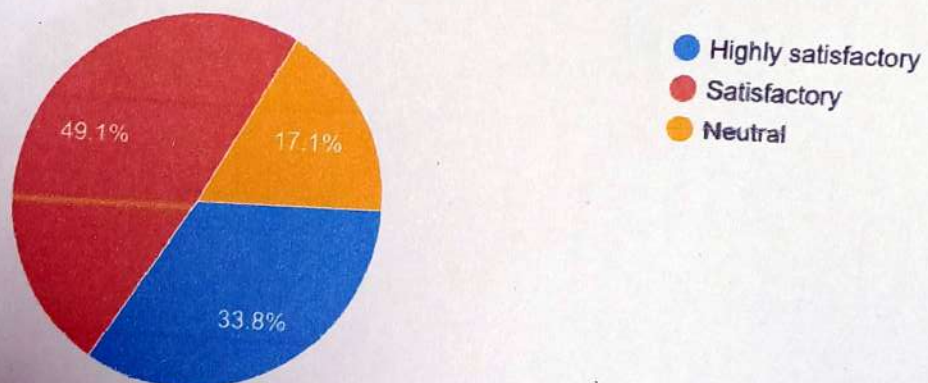

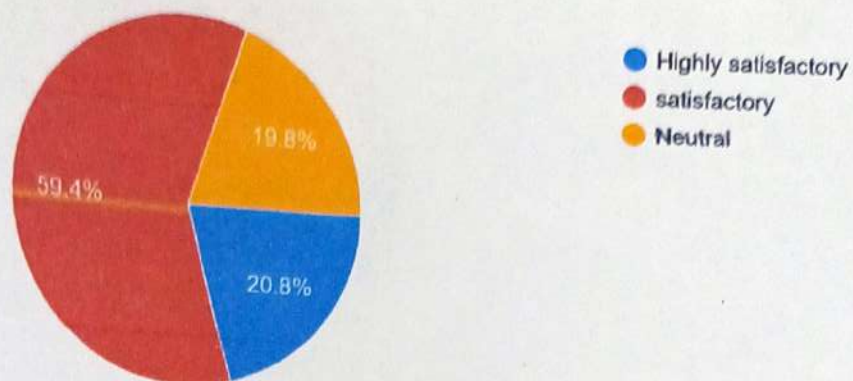

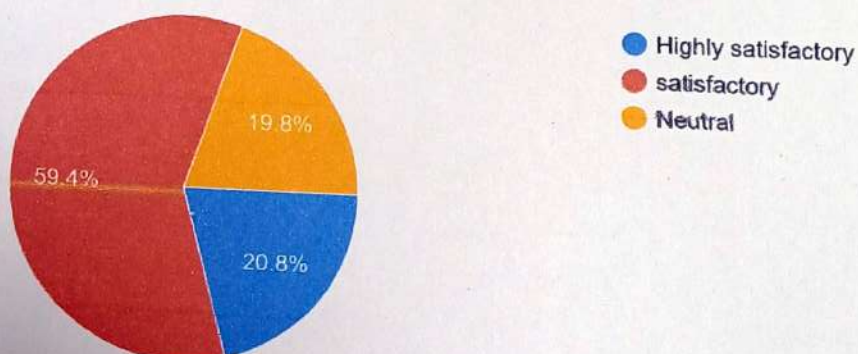

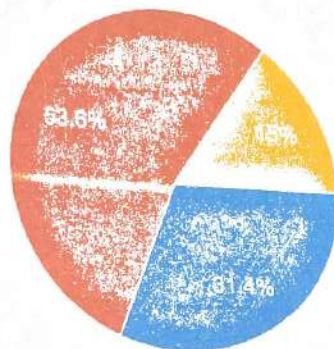

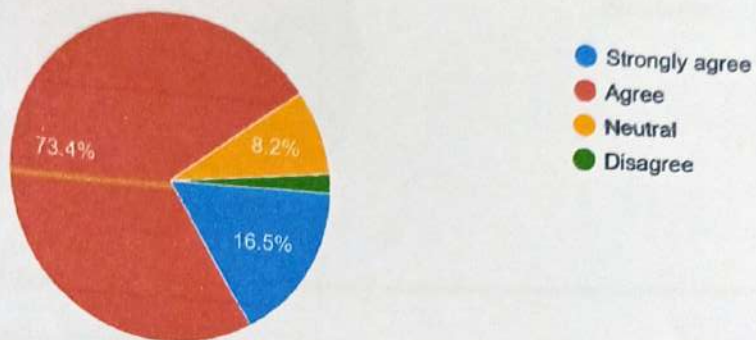

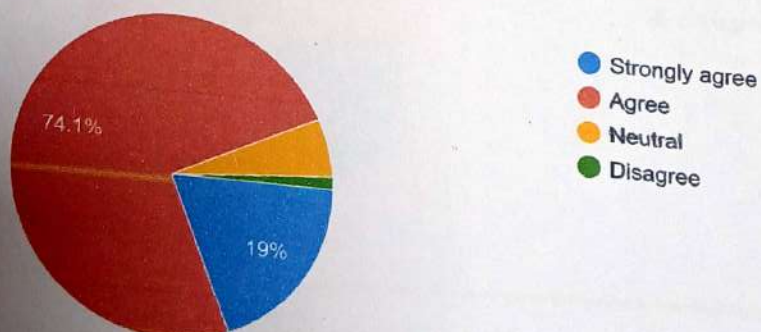

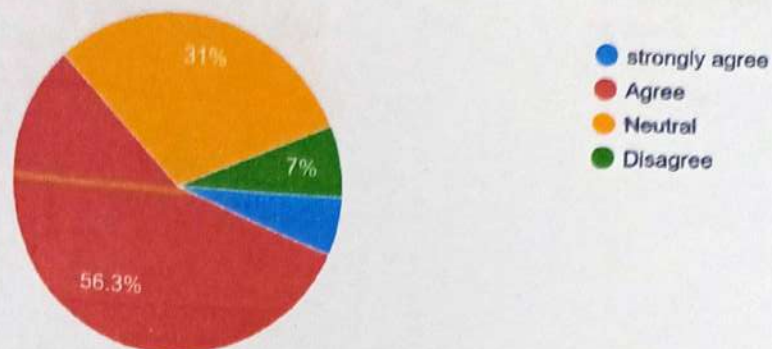

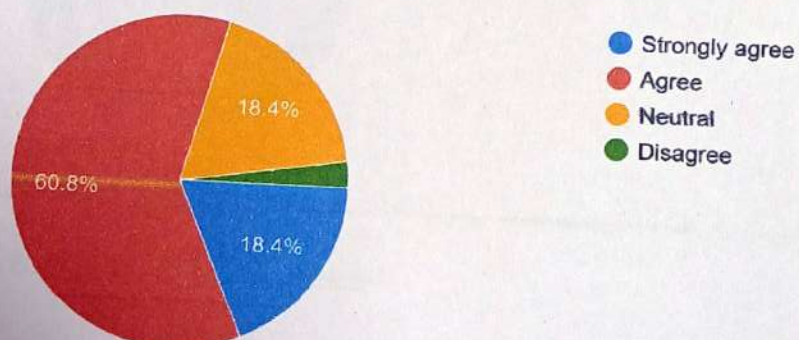

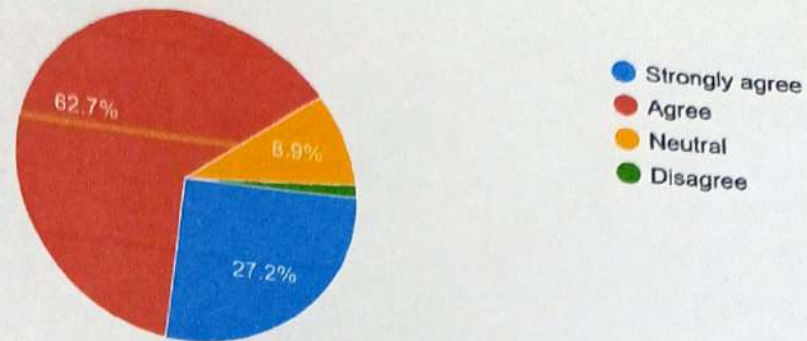

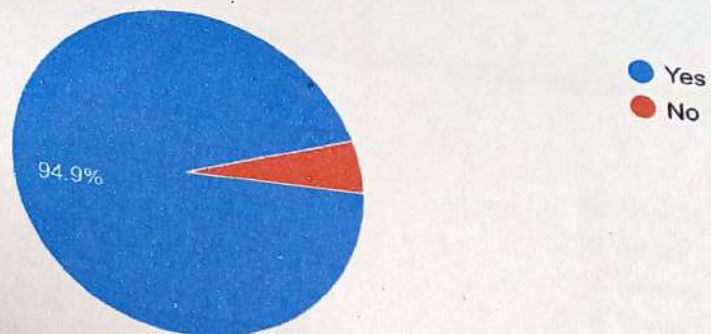

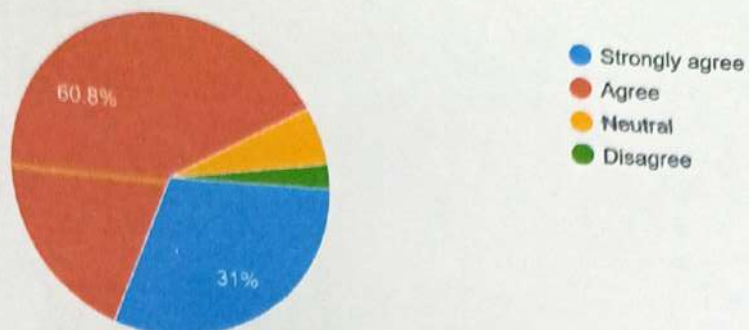

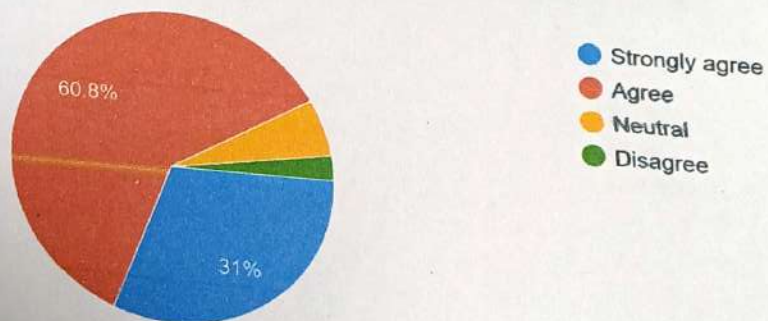

**Action Taken Report on Feedback by Institution
Academic Session: 2022-23**

The institution developed an online Feedback system for all stakeholders on curriculum. College has developed a Exam grievances Cell in college for students. Students give their feedback on Curriculum, laboratories, Library, teaching methodology, infrastructure, Co-Po's etc. Their feedback and suggestions are discussed before the committees and actions are taken accordingly by Principal.

In session 2022-23 following actions are taken

1. On suggestion of students New skill development courses are introduced. College started TCS training for interested candidates. Ekarma- certificate course is also introduced for BCA classes.
2. Library is upgraded by introducing new reference books and students were given subscription of E-library resource.
3. Exam Grievance Cell is made to address the problems of students related to Evaluation system.
4. Workshops and FDP conduction is also kept in future planning of Institution.
5. Three Mock drill are arranged before NAAC to guide departments and teachers for NAAC preparation.
6. To make internal assessment Continuous and transparent Internal assessment bifurcation is uploaded on website and students were shown it before upload.
7. To make campus Employee friendly crutch is opened for children of faculty members.
8. MOU's are signed with some organizations to sensitize students about environmental issues and to inculcate moral values in students.
9. Entrepreneur cell is opened to make Students Independent- Atmanirbhar.
10. FDP's are also planned for non-Teaching staff to train them in new ICT tools used in offices.


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
